### “BITES FOR LIGHTS” CHRISTMAS LIGHT RECYCLING PROGRAM

The Crow Wing County Land Services Department, in cooperation with Sunrise Sertoma of Brainerd and Kenwood Recycling, is collecting unneeded Christmas lights and extension cords at select locations throughout Crow Wing County. The copper found in the old extension cords and Christmas lights is recycled through Kenwood Enterprises, keeping these materials out of the county landfill. Proceeds from the recycled materials are donated to local charities.

“We collected 5,718 pounds in 2014 which amounted to \$1,000.00” stated Jeff Hilborn of Sunrise Sertoma. Over \$4,600.00 has been raised since the program began in 2010 to help purchase meals at soup kitchens and local food shelves in the Brainerd Lakes Area. County Land Services Director Mark Liedl commented “We are pleased to partner with Sunrise Sertoma to help those in need while promoting recycling.”
